Welcome:

Titan Sports & Performance Center would like to take the opportunity to welcome you and your team to the Indoor Soccer Program.

We will be running indoor leagues throughout the year and invite you to participate in all various seasons. Enjoy the friendly competition, the chance to meet new friends and time to visit with old friends.

Seasons:

The season will consist of 8 games played over a period of 8-10 weeks. Each team will play once or twice per week. Schedules may be adjusted due to holidays and or special events.

Pay dates:

- Sunday & Monday nights

Fees:

Team Registration:

- Team fees are \$450 per team and season. Team must be paid in full before the beginning of the season.

League Games:

- Team must bring \$10 to each game to pay the referee.

Reschedule Policy:

Teams are responsible to communicate with program director 48 hours before game they intend on rescheduling.

- If team communicates within the 48 hours they will be responsible for \$20 referee fee

- If team communicates before the 48 hours, there will be no penalty for the reschedule

Roster Requirements:

All teams must have a maximum of 14 players registered to their roster. The name of each individual must be on the roster before the beginning of the season.

Number of Players on field:

- Men's open will play 7v7, 6 field players and 1 goal keeper
- Adult COED will play 7v7, 3 guys and 3 girls must be on field, plus a goal keeper

Equipment:

- Same or similar color jerseys must be worn by team members, goal keeper must wear different color than both teams playing.
- If there is a color conflict between opposing teams, Home team will be asked to change to a different color.
- Players can wear cleats or running shoes on turf
- Shin guards are a requirement to play. If player does not have shin guard they will not be allowed to play

Red Card Misconduct:

- The Referee has the right to eject a player, coach or spectator before, during or after the game. That person must leave the facility immediately.
- Fighting or abusive language will result in an automatic red card and player must leave game and facility immediately
- If player receives a red card, referee will write a report of the incident and will review it with the head referee and program director. Player will have to sit out a game or will be expelled from playing at Titan depending on the severity of the incident.

- NO REFUNDS for expelled players.

Game time:

- Each game will consist of 22 minute halves and a maximum of 4 minute half time.
- If a team does not show up 10 minutes into the scheduled game time, that team will forfeit and the team that showed up will be awarded a 3-0 win

Kickoff:

- The kickoff does not have to go forward. Players may not cross the mid-field stripe until the ball is kicked. Goals may be scored directly from kickoff

Fouls:

- Referee has final word when it comes to any infraction. Any type of incident where the ball is not played will be a foul. For example, tripping, holding, kicking, pushing, charging or any dangerous play will be considered a foul.
- Field players are not allowed to slide tackle
- Goal keeper are only allowed to slide within their goalie box

Penalties:

- Due to dangerous play, the referee has the ability to penalize a player by having the player leave the game for 2 minutes. In this case, the team that has been penalized will play a man down until the referee waves a player back on. This includes all field players and goal keepers.
- Any player receiving a second blue card in a game shall be shown a red card and will be suspended from the rest of the game and will need to leave the facility immediately

Encroachment:

- All restarts shall be given 3 yards of clearance by the defending team
- If player taking the free kick request distance, the player must wait for the referee to whistle to kick the ball into play
- In a free kick, the legal distance between the ball and the defensive wall must be 3 yards
- If player that was awarded a foul decides to play quick, no encroachment will be provided to the kicker
- A defensive foul in the box will result in a penalty kick for the offensive team. Whistle must be blown to execute the penalty kick

Inbounds Restarts:

- The ball will be considered out of bounce when the ball goes over the perimeter wall and hits the overhead net
- Instead of throw-ins, team that is awarded the restart will place the ball on the ground and pass it in
- Player kicking the ball in will have a maximum of 5 seconds to get the ball into play
