(18+ Adult Division)

Pre-Game:

1. Players must find the scoring table and sign the paper next to their name to register their attendance per game.

2. Players may practice and shoot around freely before the game begins.

3. Home teams will receive the ball first.

Team Composition:

1. Teams may consist of up to 5 players.

2. Teams must have 3 players on the court at all times.

3. Guest players/teams may play on a scheduled gameday upon registration at the front desk. A. Substitutions may play at the price of \$10 per game. B. Guest players must play at the same level of who they are subbing for. C. For playoff games, please reach out to the Sports Corrdinator in charge for approval of guest players.

4. There must be a Team Captain for every team that can be easily contacted to distribute news to their team. The Team Captain is decided by the people on the team.

League Attire

1. Proper athletic attire is required.

2. All players must wear a short sleeve, or long sleeve athletic style t shirt.

3. All players must wear either athletic shorts or leggings/tights.

4. All sports accessories, such as headbands, sleeves, braces, etc. are permitted.

5. All jewelry besides necklaces/chains that stay tucked are not permitted to be worn during the game. This includes all earrings, bracelets, and rings.

6. Apple or any smart watches may be worn if with the purpose of tracking fitness, all other watches are not permitted to be worn.

7. Athletic tennis shoes are required to be worn. Relaxed fitted shoes such as Hey Dudes or Crocs are permitted to be worn as well. No boots, sandals, flip flops, or any other type of shoes are allowed.

Game Duration:

1. Games will be played until one team scores 21 total points.

2. A team can only win if they are up by at least 2 points.

3. A 30-minute timer will start when the game begins and if the game is not over by 30 minutes then the winner will be decided by overtime:

a. If a team is up by any points when the timer ends, then they will receive the win.

b. If the game is tied then a 2 minute break will be called before they go into sudden death.

c. 5 points will be added to the tie score, that then becomes the goal score. First to receive this score wins. EX: 19 point tie; Winning score now becomes first to 24, win by 2.

4. Both teams will be given 2 timeouts that last 1 minute. a. (Timeouts do not stop the 30-minute timer unless there is less than 3 minutes left.)

5. Timeouts may only be called in the event of an injury or if your team has possession of the ball.

Scoring:

1. Scoring will be counted as 1 point for shots within the arc, and 2 points for shots beyond the arc.

Every successful free throw shall be awarded 1 point.

Gameplay:

1. Teams must pass the ball in from the top of the arc to start gameplay.

2. Standard offensive and defensive basketball rules apply.

3. The game is played in an alternate position format. a. Not make it take it.

Fouls:

1. Standard fouls and violations will be enforced and called when necessary.

2. All fouls will result in the team that was afflicted retaining or obtaining possession at the top of the arc. a. Note: After 5 fouls on one player, they will start to receive

technicals, after 2 technicals they will be benched for the remainder of the game. 3. There is zero tolerance for violent or disrespectful behavior, any violation of this protocol can result in the game supervisor having you benched for the remainder of the game.

4. You may celebrate and boast as you wish, but do not bring any harm to an opposing player, any violation of this protocol can result in the game supervisor having you benched for the remainder of the game.

SEE THE FOLLOWING OFFICIALS GUIDELINES:

Officiating:

1. Officials will be an outside source coming in that isn't apart of the game.

3. Officials will be encouraged to be lenient on calling any and all fouls. This is meant to be an organized pickup league. So fouls will not be called in an excessive manner unless deemed necessary.

4. Players are allowed to speak with the official on any occasion regarding a call or missed call. If you speak with an official, you are required to maintain a mature manner. If you become violent or disrespectful with an official then the game supervisor will step in to solve the issue.
